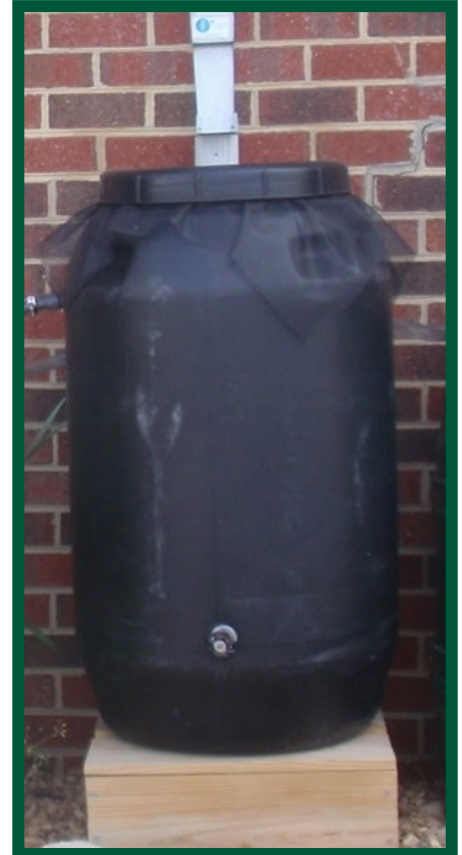

Why Rain Barrels?

Rain barrels can be attached to downspouts to capture roof runoff. Water stored in a rain barrel can be used to water gardens or lawns. Rain barrels can also help control stormwater runoff, which can cause erosion.

- Convert a heavy plastic pickle barrel into a functional rain barrel
- Learn how to install and maintain a rain barrel
- Learn how they impact local waterways
- Learn their role in water conservation and water quality protection
